SB/XA-20824	SB+ > Admin > SB+ Setup > Control Parameters > GUI Parm s, contains a new field named Get Grid Field Justification from Field Definition. Set this to Yes to get the justification for grid fields directly from the field definition (/FD > F6 - Addit > Justification). Note: Screen drivers must be generated after changing this value. SB/XA-19748	Closing an SBClient session with the X at the top-right corner of the main window now performs proper clean-up of SB/XA licenses on UniVerse for Unix. Previously, SBClient sessions that were closed using the top-right X were reported as invalid licenses in /RELEASE . LICENSES . This issue is fixed.	Admin Tools
SB/XA-20590	For SBClient SSH Communications, the SSH Host Name may be prefixed with a username. For example: myusername@myserver . In this scenario FTP/SFTP file transfers work as expected. Previously, if you prefixed the SSH Host Name with a username then FTP/SFTP file transfers failed, creating a 0KB file.	Communications / File Transfer
SB/XA-21069	The TU.BUILD.XFER.DATA internal subroutine code is optimized such that it can parse multiple multivalue SORT fields in a selection as required. Previously, the TU.BUILD.XFER.DATA internal	External Application Integration

SB/XA-20535	<p>SB/XA challenges users to enter their password for access to protected functions such as the User Security Setup screen or on Keyboard Timeout. The SB/XA password challenge in GUI mode now accepts a password up to 80 characters in length. Previously, the SB/XA password challenge in GUI mode accepted a password up to 15 characters in length before resetting the input field.</p>	GUI Forms/Functions
SB/XA-21052	<p>When a multi-line message is sent to the mainwin status bar, mainwin is not re-sized; the status bar is re-sized within mainwin to accommodate the extra lines. Previously, mainwin was resized every time a multi-line message was sent to the status bar, and did not reset. A self-contained form will re-size to accommodate a multi-line message that is sent to the status bar and reset when the form is closed. Previously, the self-contained form re-sized every time a multi-line message was sent to the status bar and did not reset.</p>	GUI Forms/Functions
SB/XA-20439	<p>When opening a record containing CRLF delimited data in the XUI SE editor, the CRLFs are no longer replaced with attribute marks that corrupt the data. Instead, CRLFs are displayed as <code>\r\n</code>. Previously, customers using a UO.NET application to populate U2 records with data that contained CRLF delimiters experienced this issue: If opening a record containing CRLF delimited data in the XUI SE editor, the CRLFs were being replaced with attribute marks.
